Directions

Master Tests will be held near Linkwood, MD. From Linkwood, MD go east about 1 mile and turn right onto Percy May Road then travel about 2 miles and turn right onto Drawbridge Road, then travel about 2.5 miles; unpaved road into test area will be on left. Follow signs to test and park where designated.

Junior and Senior Tests will be held at LeCompte Wildlife Management Area near Vienna, MD. From Cambridge, MD, travel east on Route 50 to Salem, turn Right onto Salem Road and go about 0.6 miles then turn right onto Ravenwood Rd., then go about 1.9 miles and turn left onto New Bridge Rd., then travel about 2.4 miles and turn right onto Steeles Neck Rd., then travel about 1.8 miles entrance to LeCompte WMA will be on your left. Follow signs to test and park where designated.

From Vienna, MD., take Elliott Island Road south, turn onto Steele Neck Road as it forks to the right and follow Steele Neck Road 4 miles to LeCompte WMA on the left.
